




He is well known for capturing international and civil conflicts such as the Iran-Iraq War, Beirut, Cambodia, the Philippines, the Gulf War and the continuing strife in Afghanistan. Steve's career high point was undoubtedly the National Geographic cover photo of the previously unidentified Afghan refugee girl, SharbatGula whom he located and photographed again nearly two decades after the original. That picture has been described as the most recognizable photograph in the world today with her being referred to as the "Afghan Mona Lisa".



One of the most famous photographers of all time, particularly known for his remarkable images of the American wilderness.

Adams placed great value upon technical mastery of his craft, carefully evaluating gradations of light in the image, manipulating the degree of exposure, and constantly experimenting with new techniques.



Ansel Adams a photographer and environmentalist, was born in San Francisco, California. When Adams was twelve he taught himself to play the piano and read music. For the next few years the piano was Adams's primary occupation and, by 1920, his intended profession.

Although he ultimately gave up music for photography, the piano brought substance, discipline, and structure to his frustrating and erratic youth.





Robert Capa

Picture Post on 3, December 1938, introduced the greatest war photographer in the World, Robert Capa. But the irony was, he hated war from the core of his heart. He was a unique visual chronicler of several 20th-century wars in the world in the history of photography.



Robert Capa whose original name was Friedmann Endre Ernö, was born in 1913 in Budapest, Hungary. In Life Magazine, he covered much of the heaviest fighting in Africa, Sicily, and Italy during the World War II.

His photographs of the Normandy Invasion became some of the most memorable of the war. The year1954 marked the end of a legend as he volunteered to photograph the French Indochina War for Life and was killed by a land mine while on assignment. His death established his reputation for being a quintessentially fearless photojournalist.




